



Metro DC Chapter/NCCUAA 2020-2021 Quarantine Scholarship Fundraiser

WHY SUPPORT THIS VIRTUAL FUNDRAISER

To help the Metro DC Chapter of the North Carolina Central University Alumni Association (MDCC-NCCUAA) raise \$20,000 to deposit in its scholarship fund established under the NCCU Foundation, Inc., a 501 (c) (3) nonprofit organization. These scholarship funds are awarded to students from the DC Metropolitan area (DC, Maryland and Virginia (DMV) who attend NCCU and need financial assistance.

Due to the Pandemic of 2020, the April 2020 Scholarship Gala was cancelled, and we were not able to fulfill our financial obligation to the Scholarship Fund.
